



Learn to Sew: Pillowcase Dress

You want sweet, simple and super cute? We're on the case—the pillowcase dress, that is! These fun dresses are easy to make and a great way to use up extra scraps of fabric.

SUPPLY LIST (for 2T size):

- Fabric for dress, $\frac{3}{4}$ yard
- Coordinating fabric for ties, $\frac{1}{8}$ " yard
- Single fold $\frac{1}{2}$ " bias tape, 1 pkg.
- Seam gauge
- Rotary cutter
- Cutting mat
- All-purpose thread
- Straight pins
- Large safety pin
- Iron and ironing board
- Sewing machine
- Fabric scissors
- Loop turner



TIPS:

- For a professional finish, use bias tape to cover armhole seams as it can easily stretch around curved areas.
- Try using a complementary fabric or ribbon for the ties.
- Want a bow on each shoulder? Simply make two ties and feed each one through the front casing and one through the back casing. Tie front and back ties together in a bow on each shoulder.
